HISTORIC GLENDALE

First settled in 1892, Glendale attracted farming families after founder W.J. Murphy dug a canal, allowing access to water for agricultural purposes. Local farms cultivated everything from sugar beets to cotton. With the

establishment of a Santa Fe Railroad Depot on Grand Avenue in 1895, Glendale blossomed into the largest town in the Northwest Salt River Valley. In 1910, the Town of Glendale was officially incorporated, and in 1911, a trolley system became operational in Glendale that would take patrons from 7th Street and Orangewood to downtown Glendale in 30 minutes.

Separated from Phoenix by miles of open space, Glendale developed its downtown with banks, grocery stores, theaters, department stores, businesses, and surrounding neighborhoods. In 1912, the Glendale News was founded, and the Glendale High



School was built at a cost of \$20,000. By 1930, Glendale was one of the nation's top produce shippers and changed its name from the Town of Glendale to the City of Glendale.

Some of Glendale's past remains visible in the historic buildings around town. Two of Glendale's historic crown jewels are one of the valley's oldest and most magnificent ranches, Sahuaro Ranch Historic Park Area, an 80-acre ranch with 13 original buildings and a huge rose garden. Founded in 1886 by William Henry Bartlett, a native of Illinois, the ranch was rich in figs and other fruit orchards, vineyards, and alfalfa fields. The other crown jewel, Historic Manistee Ranch, was founded in 1897 by Herbert W. Hamilton, a native of Wisconsin. The ranch was rich in citrus fruits and dates and was also one of the last working cattle ranches in the Valley. Manistee Ranch is listed in the U.S. Register of Historic Places and is open to the public for historical tours on the 1st and 3rd Saturday of each month from October through May.

Today, Historic Downtown Glendale comprises two neighborhoods spanning ten square blocks. The first neighborhood, Catlin Court, with its white picket fences and mature shade trees, welcomes visitors to the bungalowsturned-specialty shops. The second neighborhood, Old Towne, boasts brick-trimmed sidewalks and glowing gaslights leading to the ethnic eateries and shops.

Glendale's official birthday is February 27, as it was on that date in 1892 that the city's first residential area began to take shape.

Feunshay Jones had big dreams. As a teenager, she imagined a life in the military—structured, purposeful, and full of promise. She was independent, thriving while studying abroad in Madrid and London, and determined to forge

her path. But life had other plans.

Diagnosed with diabetes at 13, Feunshay's military dreams were deferred early. Years later, while on a family vacation, something changed. Her energy vanished. Her body felt different. In December 2020, she was diagnosed with lupus nephritis, a chronic autoimmune disease that would soon demand everything she had.

Lupus can quietly attack the body's organs—in Feunshay's case, her kidneys, but it also affected her heart and lungs, along with a blood disorder and many other health issues. Over time, the damage progressed into renal failure. There were extended hospital stays, exhausting treatments, and near-constant medical appointments. At one point, COVID, pneumonia, and RSV combined to leave her in a wheelchair, her blood pressure soaring over 300. Another time, fluid buildup caused temporary blindness. She underwent chemotherapy, faced a dangerous heart clot, and began regular dialysis treatments.

Through it all, Feunshay remained determined not just to survive, but to find a new dream. She found it in the hospital hallways.

During treatment, Feunshay began to notice the nurses, not just what they did, but how they did it. She saw skill,





compassion, and presence. And slowly, a new calling emerged. She has now earned her Patient Care Technician certificate.

Later, while working to transport dialysis patients, she listened to them vent, reassure one another, and sometimes lose hope. She understood every word. After her shift ended, she would quietly receive her dialysis. That duality offering strength to others while managing her own—defines Feunshay's resilience.

She then applied to Grand Canyon University and completed all her nursing coursework, with support from Disability Services to help her juggle dialysis and exams. Her clinicals are planned for September, but they hinge on one critical detail: a kidney transplant.

The transplant would be life-changing. With a functioning kidney, Feunshay could reclaim stability, finish her training, and finally begin the career she's fought so hard to reach. She has already been on the waiting list for three years, with a timeline that ranges from three to seven years, depending on the center. She's currently listed at multiple transplant centers, including Banner Health, the Mayo Clinic in Arizona, and UW Medicine in Madison, Wisconsin.

The wait in Wisconsin is shorter, but it comes with complications. If a kidney becomes available, Feunshay must answer the phone within one hour. After that, she and her mother must travel to Madison as soon as possible. All followups and labs would take place there, meaning temporary relocation, housing, and full-time caregiving.

Her mother, Latanya, would go with her. She always does. Her mother is an absolute inspiration, giving her full attention to the fight for her daughter's health. LaTanya had a fullservice salon and a child care center many years ago. It may seem like a great sacrifice to have given up so much to take care of her daughter, but her mother says, "I would give up everything, as long as I have her here with me."

Latanya has been a tireless advocate, researching treatment plans, coordinating care, and managing the overwhelming logistics of long-term illness. At one point, doctors considered her a match to donate her kidney, but complications from a car accident may make the match too risky. Still, she pushes forward—quietly, persistently, looking for any path that might help her daughter heal.

They are now hoping for a living donor—someone with Type O or A blood who is healthy and willing to go through initial testing. The process is straightforward and fully covered by Feunshay's insurance. Labs and evaluations can be completed in a single day. The impact would last a lifetime.

Much of Feunshay's care—including her dialysis, transplant eligibility, and future medications—is currently covered through Medicaid, a lifeline that makes her treatment possible.

Of course, the transplant isn't the end of the journey. Antirejection medication will be critical for the rest of Feunshay's life. One of those medications alone could cost over \$1,800 per month. But after years of uncertainty and pain, she is ready for stability. Ready to build something new.

Lupus has taken years from her. At just 29, Feunshay has already spent holidays, birthdays, and full seasons in the hospital. Her weight and appearance have changed. Her body has fought



Sonoita/Elgin wine region Arizona

If you are a wine drinker or would love to see more of our state, we recommend a trip to the Southern Arizona wine region. We featured an article on the history of the wine industry in Arizona and highlighted the Verde Valley region. This article will feature the second region, Sonoita/Elgin.

Los Milics Vineyards

Nestled in the rolling hills of southern Arizona, this hidden gem has rapidly gained recognition for its exceptional wines. Located just 50 miles southeast of Tucson, this picturesque area is renowned for its unique terroir, which includes high elevation, diverse soils, and a temperate climate —perfect conditions for grape cultivation. The region has a deep agricultural history, but it wasn't until the 1980s that viticulture truly took root. The first commercial vineyards were planted by Sonoita Vineyards, which opened in 1983, making it Arizona's first commercial winery. Today, the region is home to more than 20 wineries. Wine enthusiasts visiting the area can sample a variety of wines, ranging from robust reds like Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah

to aromatic whites such as Sauvignon Blanc and Chardonnay. Many wineries offer tastings in scenic, rustic settings, allowing visitors to experience the beauty of the desert landscape while savoring a glass of their favorite wine.

The wineries and vineyards we visited include:

1) Dos Cabezas WineWorks—Our first stop was this tasting room in Sonoita. With two farms in southern Arizona, this winery specializes in dry reds (I had the all-red flight) and offers flights of white, rosé, and sparkling wines. Open every day, Dos Cabezas is also known for its wood-fired pizza and full menu of food, including unique desserts. We highly recommend purchasing a \$15 "local

glass," which can be used for tastings at all wineries (except Los Milics).

2) Rune Wines - This off-grid, solarpowered winery (one of the only ones in the country) is located in Elgin. Rune had its first vintage in 2013. The wine tasting menu changes, but typically includes 5 to 6 white or red wines to sample. The winery produces stories on its labels on each wine (170 different labels to date). The story unfolds like a novel, with each volume featuring an original rendering by artist Daniel Helzer on the front and an excerpt on the back. The whole story for each type of wine can be found on the Rune Wines website. Visitors can enjoy this exceptional setting while sipping wine under a shade canopy, taking in the



panoramic views of the surrounding high desert and mountain ranges. Guests can enjoy seasonal small bites, charcuterie boards, and sandwiches. Rune is open every day.

3) Los Milics Vineyards - This 20-acre estate, surrounded by vineyards and mountains, was named to USA Today's 10 Best Readers' Choice Awards 2024

for "Best Tasting Rooms" in the country.
The winery cultivates 17 different
grape varieties, and its Rosé wine,
called Sandra's, is named after the late
U.S. Supreme Court Justice Sandra Day
O'Connor from Arizona. Sandra won
the Governor's Cup wine competition.
Of course, I had to buy a bottle as I
had the privilege of meeting her at the
Supreme Court. The Tasting room offers

small plates and tapas to pair with your wines. Los Milics also has 9 - 1 bedroom casitas on the property, located near the vineyards. Each offers a modern, open design, along with a private patio that boasts stunning views of the vineyards and the Mustang Mountains. Casitas book months in advance. Coming soon, the tasting room will transform into

"The Clarks Go to Disneyland"





Street Corn Salsa

- 1/2 bunch of Cilantro
- Juice of 1 lime (about 2 tbls)
- 1/2 tsp chili powder
- Salt and pepper to taste

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Open the Corn and drain: You can choose to brown the corn in oil in a frying pan or not. Add to solo bowl.
- 2. Mix the Dressing: In a separate large bowl, combine mayo, sour cream, lime juice, garlic, chili powder, and a pinch of salt and pepper.
- 3. Combine the salad: Add the corn, cotija cheese, chopped jalapeno, and cilantro to the bowl. Toss everything together until well-coated.
- **4. Taste and adjust:** Add more lime juice, chili powder, or salt to taste. If you want it spicier, toss in an extra jalapeno or a dash of hot sauce. Serve chilled, and **ENIOY!**
