





FROM A One-Year Stay to A Lifelong Sanctuary

How Britt and Bob Michaelian Built a Healing-Filled Life on Lido After Life's Unexpected Turns

Britt and Bob Michaelian moved to Newport Beach from San Francisco in 2010. It wasn't a long-term plan to stay here; in fact, it was only supposed to be a year. However, right after Bob sold his company in San Francisco, Britt's mom was diagnosed with lung cancer, so it was a transition that made sense. It allowed the family to support their elders during a sensitive time. And it ended up being an honor for Britt that she was able to hold her mom as she passed.

In January of 2020, the Michaelians purchased a home on Via Koron. While Britt and Bob's three daughters have left the proverbial nest, their eldest daughter, Maya, lives on the Peninsula and works as head of marketing for a music management, record label, and publishing company. Middle daughter, Lucy, is a songwriter and producer with Universal Music Publishing Group in Los Angeles. The youngest daughter, Soleil, is studying music production and DJing in London and occasionally DJs at clubs in Ibiza. Neither Britt nor Bob plays an instrument (other than crystal sound bowls), but a passion for music clearly runs in the family.

Britt graduated from Corona Del Mar High School and went on to get a BFA from the School of the Art Institute of Chicago and master's degrees in art therapy and marriage and family therapy. Britt did her practicum and got certified as an art therapist in the hospital setting at CPMC, a San Francisco hospital, in the oncology, heart transplant, and pediatric units. At the same time, her art was exhibited in galleries in NY, SF,











documentary, and a panel discussion with Britt Michaelian, and the curators of Britt's art, Aubrie Weinholt of Weinholt Projects and Frederick Janka, president of the board of the Museum of Contemporary Art Santa Barbara. The next Healing House will take place on January 26, 2026 at the Lido Theater. As always, guests will be treated to a sound bath, guided meditation, and group Reiki healing infused with Britt's seven daily healing practices through art, but this year will also include a live interview with Kelly Noonan Gores for the *Heal with Kelly* podcast. Tickets will be available at Britt's website at brittmichaelian.art, and twenty percent of proceeds from the event will benefit City of Hope.

Bob and Britt love the friendly atmosphere in our little touch of heaven on Lido. In fact, they love it so much, they moved Bob's mom down to the island in 2023. They also adore the surrounding Newport Beach community. They've been long-time fans of Vibe Organic Kitchen, Fable & Spirit, and Ekam Yoga. When he's not on his yoga mat, taking calls for work, or walking with Ziggy and Britt, Bob can be found on the water, as an avid standup and prone paddleboarder. The Michaelians are wellness enthusiasts who clearly love the Lido lifestyle, but the best days are when their daughters come to visit.


LA, and Chicago, and collected around the world. Britt has worked as an artist and healer for over 20 years.


In 2017, right after Britt became a Reiki master, her sister was diagnosed with cancer. Britt had taken a break from painting for a few years after her mom passed, and her sister decided it was time for Britt to pick up the paintbrush again. She got Britt several paint-by-number kits and instructed Britt to paint while her sister slept. One day, after Britt put Reiki healing energy into her sister's back to ease the pain, she was struck by a divine message that her art could serve as a Reiki healing transmission. From that moment on, Britt's art shifted from being abstract color expressionist to frequency art.

To be of service to the community in a way that honors her mother and sister, Britt created Healing House, an annual art and wellness event that's been featured in the *LA Times*. In August, Britt hosted a mini Healing House at the Ecology Center of San Juan Capistrano's Peace Dome. It is her dream to bring the Healing House experience to hospitals so patients, staff, and visitors have a place to go for relaxation and meditation, while receiving healing from her frequency art.

Healing House 2024 was held at the SLS Hotel in Beverly Hills and included a sound bath and guided meditation by Marcelo Shriman of the Akhanda Institute of Yoga in Rishikesh, a talk by Kelly Noonan Gores of the *Heal*

Paw-litely Towering Above the Rest

Meet Fiona, the towering gentle giant who's all legs and lots of love.

Did you know that Irish Wolfhounds, the tallest dog breed, used to be a prized hunting breed and a breed used in wars? Yes, this sweet and polite pup could have been a hunting dog in another life. Nowadays, Irish wolfhounds are

known to be very polite and family-friendly dogs that are truly the tallest dog breed, with some males reaching up to 35 inches at the shoulder.

Fiona, Lido's own Irish Wolfhound who will be two years old later this year, was born all the way in Arizona. As a small puppy, she was brought here to the Golden State by her owner, Kristy Ferell. Her sister, Lars, is also from this breeder, and they even share the same father!

Fiona and her sister both eat and live a rigorous life. To maintain a healthy body, Fiona is fed a half-meat and halfkibble diet, which helps her achieve her weight of 120 pounds, the optimal weight for her breed and age. She is walked every morning by the beach so she can exert her energy, but often does not jump into the waves. I originally thought these dogs would be very hard to walk since they have so much energy, but although she and her sister are walked separately, they both only need one long walk and some smaller walks to get the wiggles out. Often, they are so tired that they lie on the

floor to nap the rest of the day. This is one reason their breed is so sought after, as they're known for being very gentle and kind, making them a truly special breed.


Both Fiona and her older sister were trained from a young age, because it can be difficult to control dogs of their size without some discipline. Now, they're as polite and well-behaved as can be. Make sure to give Fiona a pet and a happy birthday if you happen to meet her in October, her birthday month!



NOW THAT WAS SOME DINNER!

bout a year ago, I wrote about an event which I called "The Great Plunder." An estate on Linda Isle was being liquidated, and a substantial inventory of wines from a beautiful and elaborate subterranean cellar was offered to me and a group of friends—for a very reasonable price. For \$3000 each and a charitable donation to Save Our Youth, six of us each took home about 80 bottles of some rare, and in some cases, very old wines. I have enjoyed several of those bottles over the last year, including a 1952 Mouton Rothschild and a 1945 Sandeman Port.

Sadly, one of the six, Chuck, passed away in December, so he did not live to enjoy most of the great wines that he got out of the deal. His significant other offered to the survivors of the group the remainder of the wines—which is to say nearly all of them. Since then, we have enjoyed a couple of dinners while opening and consuming some of these wines. We always make sure that we raise a glass to honor Chuck's name.

Recently, one of the members hosted a dinner at his home. One guy brought a half dozen bottles of wine, and the rest of us contributed in some form to the meal. I grilled some shrimp (seasoned with Old Bay) and my signature appetizer: a piece of toast with a slice of fig topped with Gorgonzola cheese. Full disclosure: I got the recipe from Dennis Brask, once the head chef at Five Crowns, who generously explained how to make what is actually a very simple and easy treat, which always receives raves.

The rest of the meal included a mixed salad, filet mignon with roasted potatoes, and an incredible dessert of thinly sliced

strawberries topped with crumbled méringue and whipped cream served with a 1970 La Forte DeLatour Sauternes.

While the dessert wine was very nice, the stars were the bottles of fine Bordeaux red wines. The lineup included Mission La Haut Brion 1985, Mouton Rothschild 1979, Chateau Margaux 1964, Lafite Rothschild 1963, Chateau Ausone 1955, and a Chateau Latour 1945. Most of these are Left Bank First Growths, which I have written about earlier this year.

We started with the Mission Haut Brion, not to be confused with Chateau Haut Brion. It started out tight and had a lot of sediment, but it came around and opened up nicely. For some reason, we did not open the Mouton (it will be saved for a future dinner). The '64 Margaux was delicious while the '63 Lafite disappointed me, but then 1963 was not one of the better vintages of that decade.

The 1955 Ausone, the only Right Bank wine in the lineup, was a bit lighter in style. Ausone is made from 50% Cabernet Franc and 50% Merlot. The vineyard gets its name from Ausonius, a Roman nobleman, and dates back nearly 2000 years. The '55 was a great vintage and a lucky one. A huge frost in early 1956 wiped out most of the vines, and it took them a few years to get back on track. Ausone is an inexpensive wine, either. This was, in fact, only the second time I have tasted this wine, the first being a 1928 (which I once got for a mere \$100) at a wine dinner about a decade ago.

The rock star wine of the night was the 1945 Latour. Harvested just a year after the Normandy landing in 1944, the '45 vintage was the first Postwar production. Wine was produced during the war years when Bordeaux was part of the Vichy Republic, but the 1945 crop enjoyed near-perfect conditions and has been called the vintage of the Century. While the label was badly damaged and the cork extraction difficult, this wine very much lived up to the legend that it has become and was in no way in decline.

Any one of the above wines would make for a dinner to remember, but to have all of them at once was an event few will ever have the good fortune to enjoy. Go ahead, be jealous!




