

As we look toward a bright new year, I want to thank our residents, readers, and local businesses for your continued


support. Your stories, photos, and involvement are what make this publication special.



All their neighbors in Casella know Brightlee, although their first introduction may have been helping to find her after one of her too-often escapes. And she can howl with


> the best of them! Still, she seems to have done an admirable job of ridding the streets of rabbits, a








But where is the story in that Kingdom of Sweets? Is it the time I wanted a plush Pound Puppy, but my brother unwrapped the chocolate lab with soft floppy ears and Santa hid my pale gray bulldog, ears knotted up like cabbages, behind the couch? Is it the morning the silver fox pounced through the snow? Or is it the first Christmas spent with the grandbabies - Phoebe's enchanted forest constructed with pillows on the living room floor?

My story is not told in one act or two. It is ever present in the dance of the flutes, of the mirliton, of the marzipan. It plays on in the beautiful waltz of childhood memories and in the pas de deux with my Cavalier. It is life's ballet. Just like for Clara, the Spirit of Christmas remains for me in the heart, not on the page.




